

Multi-Factor Authentication

Summary

- Previously, Shibumi supported authentication via single sign-on and username / password entry. When security requirements mandated Multi-Factor Authentication, the client could require authentication using SSO to leverage the MFA capabilities available from their Identity Provider (IDP).
- Many clients had a requirement for MFA but could not require SSO, because e.g., they had contracted users accessing their solution who were not managed by their IDP.
- Now, Shibumi offers the ability for an enterprise to require MFA.

Applicable to

• Authentication, Enterprise Administration

<u>Set up</u>

- An Enterprise Admin can require MFA from the Enterprise Administration Security tab or a user can configure MFA from the My Account dialog.
- If a user does not authenticate with SSO, upon first login attempt the user is prompted to configure MFA.



Set up (continued)

- To configure MFA, select "Setup MFA" and scan the QR code with an Authenticator app on a mobile device.
- Enter the 6-digit code from the Authenticator app and select 'Validate'.
- The login page will be displayed, after entering username, the user is also prompted to enter both a validation code and a password.
- Note: If an Enterprise Admin enables MFA while you are logged in, you will be asked to set up MFA upon refresh.

Ability to Disable Data Exporting

Summary


- Previously, users had the ability to export data from Shibumi via Lists, Views, Tables, the Export/Import section, and by downloading published presentations.
- Security teams for many of our clients have wanted the ability to restrict the ability to export data from the solutions.
- Now, there is an enterprise setting that enables you to prohibit exporting data.

Applicable to

• Lists, Views, Tables, the Export/Import section, and published presentations

<u>Set up</u>

- To disable exporting, as an Enterprise Admin, navigate to the Enterprise Admin Security tab.
- De-select the "Allow Data Export" checkbox in the File Control section. This will delete any scheduled exports configured in the enterprise.



<u>Notes</u>

- This setting prevents export from Lists, Views, & Tables, & Export / Import sections. It also prevents downloads of published presentations.
- For App Admins, this setting does not restrict the export of templates and apps since these do not contain production data.

Sunset Notice

As a result of routine security reviews and audits, we have introduced two modifications that may impact your use of Shibumi. Please contact your account team if you have any questions or concerns about either item.

1. The following change is effective with this release:

• Shibumi can no longer be displayed via an iFrame from another application (i.e., Shibumi cannot be embedded in another solution using an iFrame).

2. The following change will be effective with the 13 January 2023 release:

- Previously, by default, Shibumi tried to connect to client email servers using TLS when sending email notifications. Secure TLS connections require that both the sending servers and recipient servers use TLS. If the receiving server does not use TLS, Shibumi would still deliver the email notifications, however the connection was not encrypted with TLS.
- Starting with release 181.0, Shibumi will only deliver email notifications using TLS. Any client server not configured to use TLS will be blocked and will no longer receive email notifications.
