Issue Resolutions

- Layouts don't load if Association Lists have a Metric Column
- Loading a page during an App upgrade can cause pages to not load after it completes
- Rich Text font changes on publish of Presentation
- Can't disable / enable data sets after failed App upgrade
- Can't configure metric data sets in a Metric View when context is set to an ancestor
- Grabber icons missing from Attachment, Dashboard & Presentation Lists
- Entering .5 for a value in a Name/Numeric or Icon/Name/Numeric Pick List results in an error

Decimal Setting for Metric Columns in Tables

Summary

- Previously, Metric Columns in Table Sections would display up to 4 decimal places.
- This led to inconsistent displays as data in the same column could have a different number of decimal places visible.
- Now, decimal settings can be configured for Metric columns in Table sections.

Applicable to

- Tables, Metric Columns

Set up

- In Configure mode on a Layout, select the Settings gear on a Table Section and choose Customize from the dropdown menu.
- Add a metric as a column then open the column menu icon that appears on hover of the column and select Configure.
- Under Metric Settings, define the number of decimal places to display (0-15).

Summary

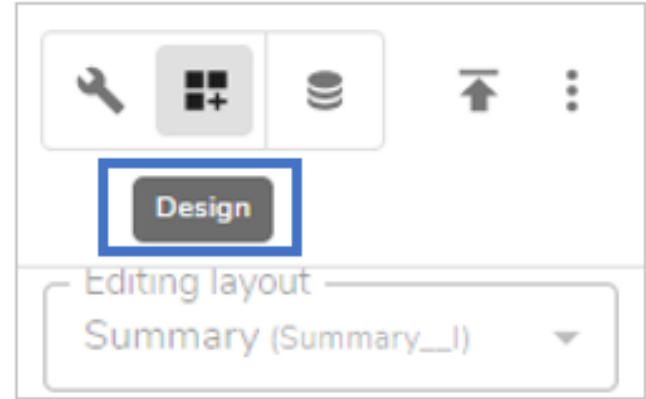
- Previously, to edit the design of a Layout, Admins would enter Layout mode.
- With the introduction of our reusable Layouts feature, it became confusing to have an edit mode with a similar name.
- Now, Admins will enter Design mode to change the layout spacing or add / remove / resize / duplicate / move sections.

Applicable to

- Templates, Dashboards, Presentations

Set up

- No set up necessary.
- On a Template, Dashboard or Presentation, select the Design button to enter Design mode.
