Global Login

Summary

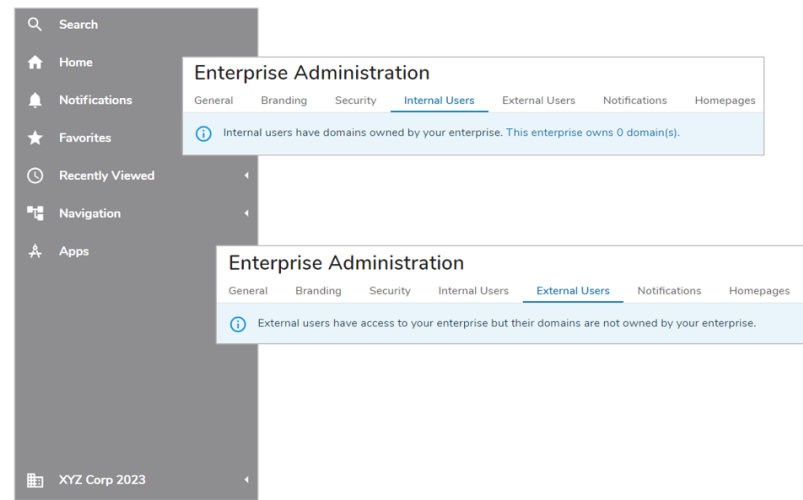
- Previously, when accessing enterprises in different regions, users authenticated into each regional Shibumi environment separately.
- If a user worked in enterprises hosted in multiple environments, it was tedious to navigate and log into each environment.
- Now, the Global Login capability enables a single authentication into Shibumi that is applied to all environments and the Enterprise List on the Navigation Sidebar is streamlined to enable quick navigation to enterprises across environments.
- Additionally, Enterprise Administration includes Internal & External Users tabs for easier user account management and to provide greater visibility to the users that have access to the enterprise.

- Login, Enterprise Admin, Navigation Sidebar

Login Changes

- Users can visit login.shibumi.com or any environment-specific login page to log in. Once logged in, you are globally authenticated.



Enterprise List in Navigation Sidebar

- The name of the current Enterprise is displayed as the Enterprise icon label. Search and a show/hide toggle are now available.

Internal/External Users Tabs in Enterprise Administration

- The Internal Users tab displays all users whose email domains are owned by the enterprise.
- The External Users tab displays all users with access to the Enterprise but whose domains are not owned by the Enterprise.

Ability to Add Captions to Card Sections

Summary

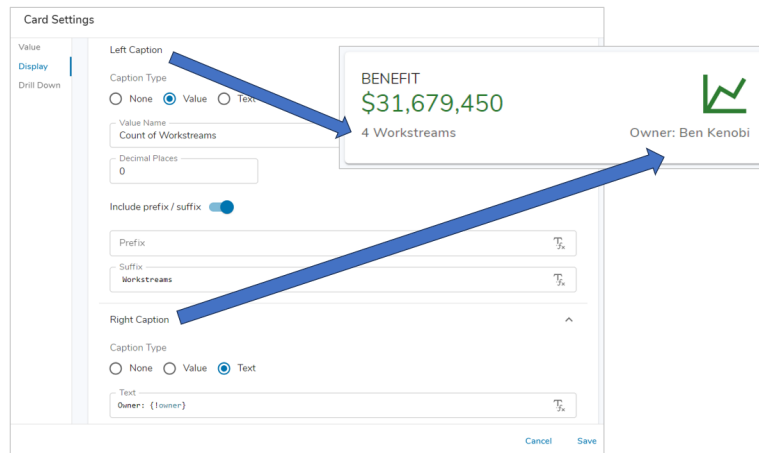
- Previously, Cards could display a Label, Value(s), and an Icon.
- To enable quick and comprehensive review of program data, App Admins wanted the ability to display additional information within their Card sections.
- Now, App Admins can add Left and Right Captions to Cards.

Applicable to

- Cards

Set up

- On a Layout in Configure mode, open the Card's Settings dialog.
- Configure one or more Values on the Value Tab of the dialog.
- On the Display Tab, select the Layout.
- Open the Left and Right Caption sections to configure the information to be displayed.



Set up cont.

- For each Caption there are three Caption Types to choose from:
 - None: no caption will be displayed.
 - Value: select a Value configured on the Value Tab to be displayed. Optionally define the decimal places and prefix/suffix.
 - Text: enter literal text or an injected expression to be displayed.
- Save and Publish your changes to the Card section.

Row Height Setting for Tables

Summary

- Previously, Table section rows were a consistent single line height.
- When cells included multi-line values, the content was truncated without any ability to expand. More problematic was when the text was multiple lines but separated by a carriage return as a user reviewing the table content might not realize that there was additional information in the cell.
- Now, App Admins can define the Row Height to be displayed for Table sections and truncated content is suffixed with an ellipsis to indicate that more content is present.

Set up

- On a Layout in Configure mode, open the Table settings dialog by clicking the Settings gear in the upper right and selecting Settings.
- Click on the Row Height setting, choose from 1-4 Lines. Save and Publish.

- When defining the Row Height setting for Tables, keep in mind that this setting will affect **ALL** rows within the Table.
- Text that cannot be displayed within the defined Row Height for a Work Item will truncate and show an ellipsis.

Sunset Notice: Legacy Forms

Summary

- In order to maintain an efficient and performant solution for all clients, we are upgrading all legacy form sections to the new & improved form sections.
- The new Shibumi forms provide enhancements that allow App Admins to:
 - Customize the form layout
 - Include dynamic headers
 - Include dynamic instructions
 - Configure conditionally required fields
 - Configure conditionally visible fields

- Legacy Form sections

Important Information

- **We are fully retiring support for the legacy Form functionality.**
- If legacy Forms are not upgraded:
 - Prior to the release deployment, all legacy Forms will be updated by the Shibumi team. The upgraded form sections will display a single column of attributes.
 - No data will be lost in this process.
