# App Validation: Display List/View Sections

#### Summary

- Previously, App Validation focused on identifying errors and warnings related to expressions in the Data Panel and Tab Visibility settings, which helped App Admins address logic-related issues.
- In addition to errors and warnings, we want to leverage App Validation to suggest best practice configurations.
- Now, App Validation has been enhanced to flag List/View sections, allowing App Admins to identify and assess their use.
- To be very clear, List and View sections do not currently have a retirement date, but our recommended best practice is to migrate to the more performant Table sections wherever possible. This Validation enhancement simply helps you find and migrate these sections more easily.

App Validation, List/View

#### Set up

 As an App Admin on the App Details page, open the More Actions dialog and select 'Validate App'.




### **Text and Date Metrics**

#### **Summary**

- Previously, Metrics in Shibumi were limited to Numeric data types, which were ideal for capturing and reporting on financials, performance targets, and other quantifiable indicators.
- While numeric metrics provided strong reporting capabilities, transformation teams needed a more holistic way to document qualitative insights and time-based milestones to fully explain and support decision-making.
- Now, Shibumi metrics can hold Date or Text data, giving teams the ability to track timelines (such as approval or completion dates) and add contextual commentary (such as rationale or status updates).
- These new metric types work seamlessly with snapshotting and tabular reporting, enabling solutions to capture a complete, timebound view of what happened, when it happened, and why enabling you to provide richer, more narrative-driven transformation reporting in Shibumi solutions.

#### **Set up Text Metrics**

- From the Data Panel on a Template, select the '+ Create Attribute' button and choose 'Metric' from the available options.
- Define a Name for the Metric, then select Text from the Type field.
- Define the Format (Single Line or Multi Line) and the Max Length (optional). Select 'Next'. Enter in any Calculations/Editable Rules for the enabled Data Sets if desired. Choose 'Create' and Publish.

#### Set up Date Metrics

- From the Data Panel on a Template, select the '+ Create Attribute' button and choose 'Metric' from the available options.
- Define a Name for the Metric, then select Date from the Type field.
- Select 'Next' and enter in any Calculations/Editable Rules for the enabled Data Sets if desired. Choose 'Create' and Publish.




# Pick List: Include Enterprise and App Colors for icons

#### **Summary**

- Previously, App Admins had the flexibility to assign custom colors to pick list icons by entering hex codes, allowing for tailored visual styling where needed.
- As solutions grew in scale and complexity, having a consistent and centralized approach to color management became increasingly valuable for ensuring alignment and simplifying updates.
- Now, Pick List icon colors can be selected from Enterprise and App colors defined within your solution, promoting visual consistency and making it easier to apply color changes across the platform.
- On release, any custom hex codes previously applied to pick list icons will be automatically converted into new App Colors, with system-generated names (e.g., Picklist Color 1, Picklist Color 2, etc.). If the same hex color was used across multiple Pick Lists, those icons will now reference a single, shared App Color, preserving consistency while aligning with the new standardized model.

#### **Applicable to**

• Pick Lists: Icon/Name/Numeric Value & Icon/Name/Text Value



#### Set up

- On a Template, open the Data Panel. Select the Settings gear from an Icon/Name/Numeric Value or Icon/Name/Text Value Pick List.
- For each Option, define the color displayed on the Icon via the Color field. The options will be derived from currently configured App Colors and Enterprise Branding Colors.
- Save and Publish your changes.



## **Sunset Notice**

#### Summary

- Effective this Release (234.0) the Metric Detail page and default Metric Tab will be sunset.
- The Metric Detail page and Metric Tab only applied to numeric metrics and was rarely used.
- With the introduction of Text and Date metric types, this functionality was no longer needed within the Shibumi platform.
